New food guidelines

It was waaaaaaay to difficult to figure out how many people would be eating each week. And very difficult to collect money every month. Sorry guys but I didn't get a lot of cooperation with on time payments so we will have to change the way we pay for food each week.

Also, if your teen comes to Wings right from school, you need to give them money to eat. They are starving and I feel bad not feeding them.

You must purchase all of the meal. You can't just give me a \$1 for dessert or wait for leftovers and think you can eat for free.

I WILL NOT ALLOW YOUR TEEN TO RUN OFF SITE TO GO GET FOOD. EVEN IF YOU TELL ME THEY CAN. IT IS VERY DIFFICULT TO KEEP TRACK OF WHERE THEY ARE AND WHO CAN GO AND WHO CANT.

We have 32 weeks of Wings. I prefer you pay the entire amount up front. That would be \$160 per teen. That is \$5 per week per teen. Trust me, it's a bargain.

If you cannot pay all at one time:

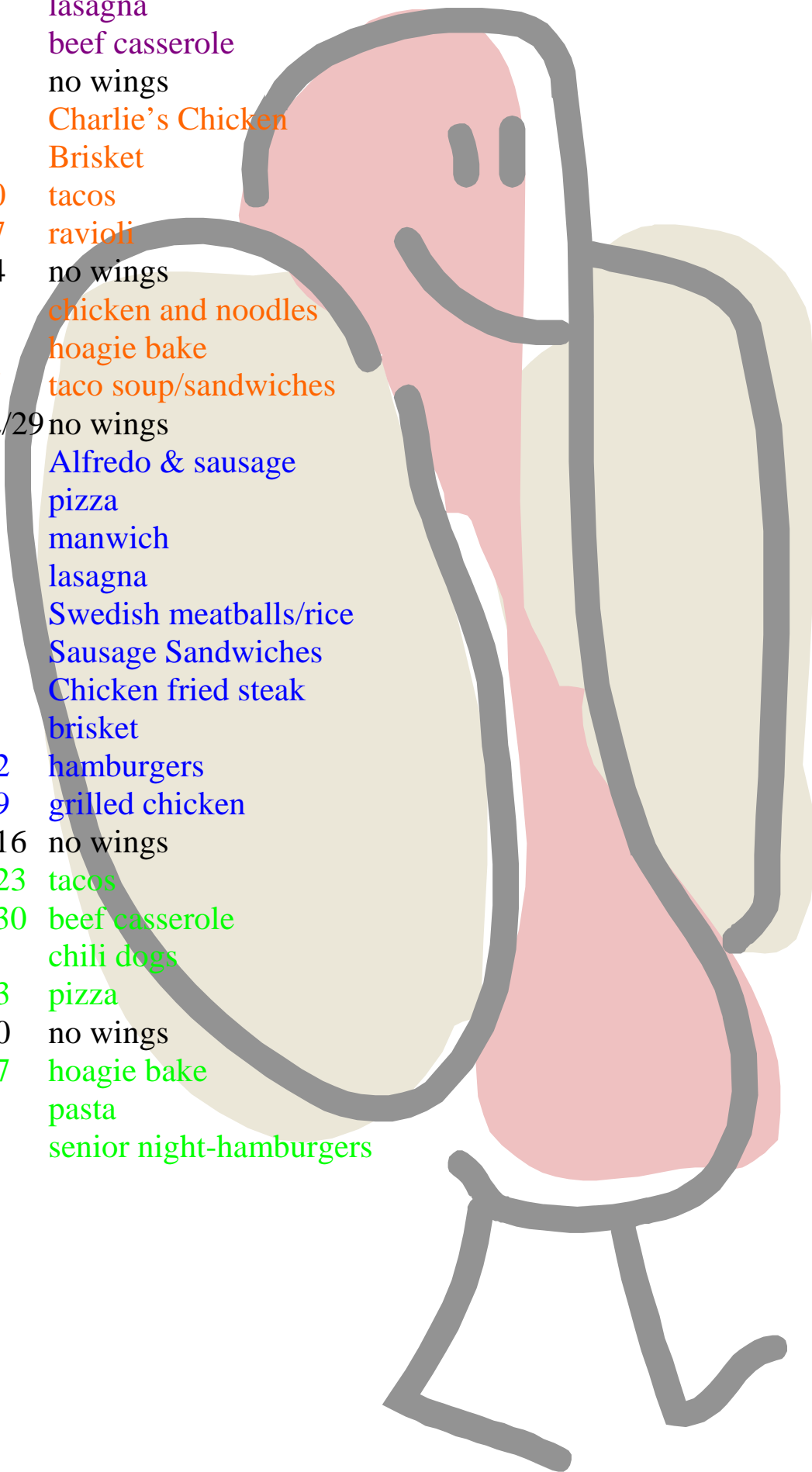
I will break it up into four payments with no exceptions given for non payment. I'll bring it next week is no longer acceptable.

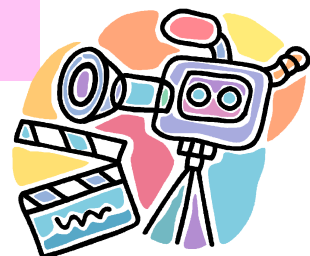
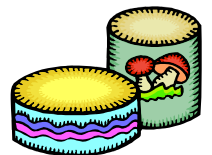

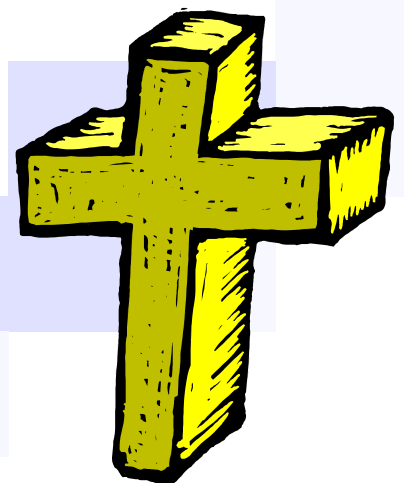
Cost: \$8.00 for dinner
